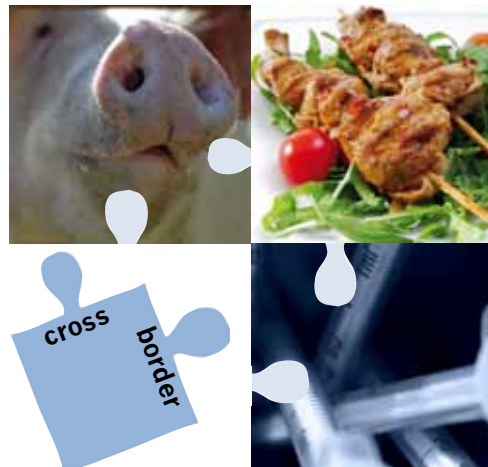

This workshop is the second meeting of a sequence of cross border events that is planned on emergency vaccination and marketing issues in the Dutch-German border area. Prior to this workshop there has been a first meeting in November 2012, where basic information on emergency vaccination strategies and economic consequences have been discussed for Classical Swine Fever (CSF) control. Afterwards Dutch and German veterinary authorities met in Kleve for a FMD table top crisis management exercise (March 2013). The results of both meetings, the first Kleve-workshop and the FMD exercise, provide the basis for this workshop.

- What are the first steps to organize commodity flow when vaccines are used in case of an epidemic?
- What is the impact of the market?
- How can expected losses be compensated?
